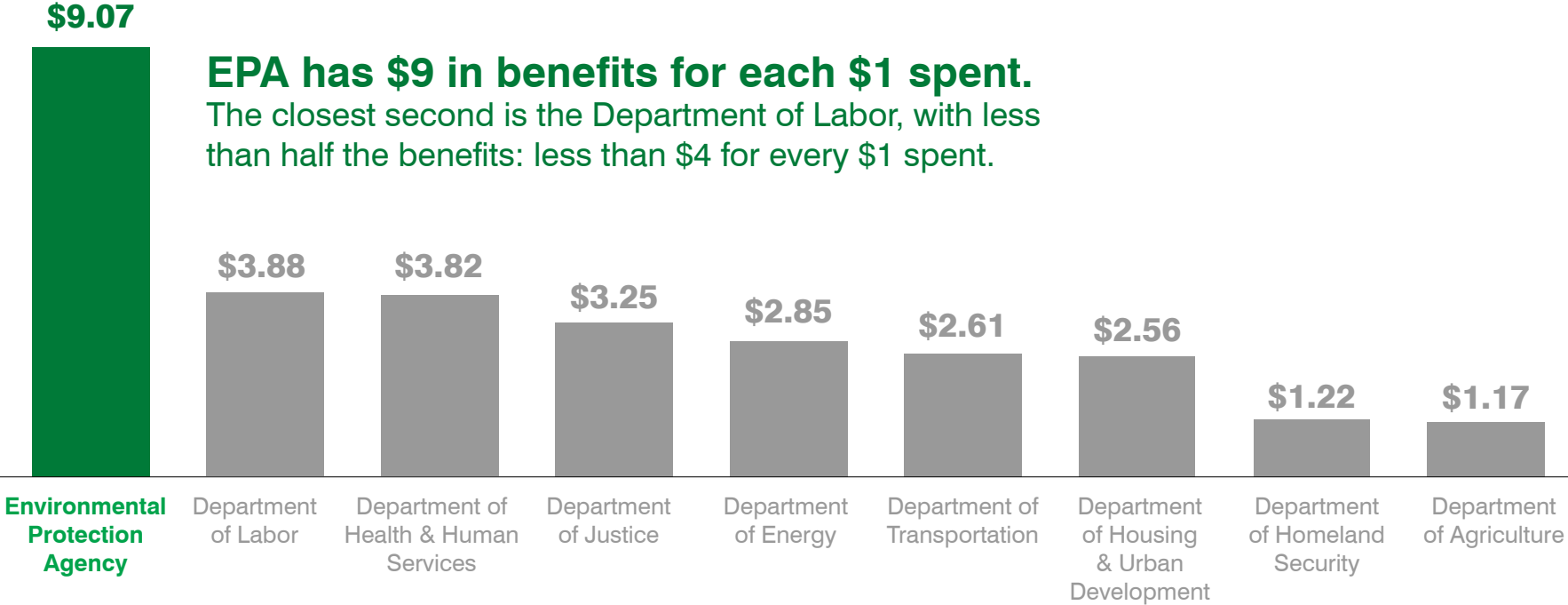


Benefits of 2005-2015 federal agency rules for every \$1 spent

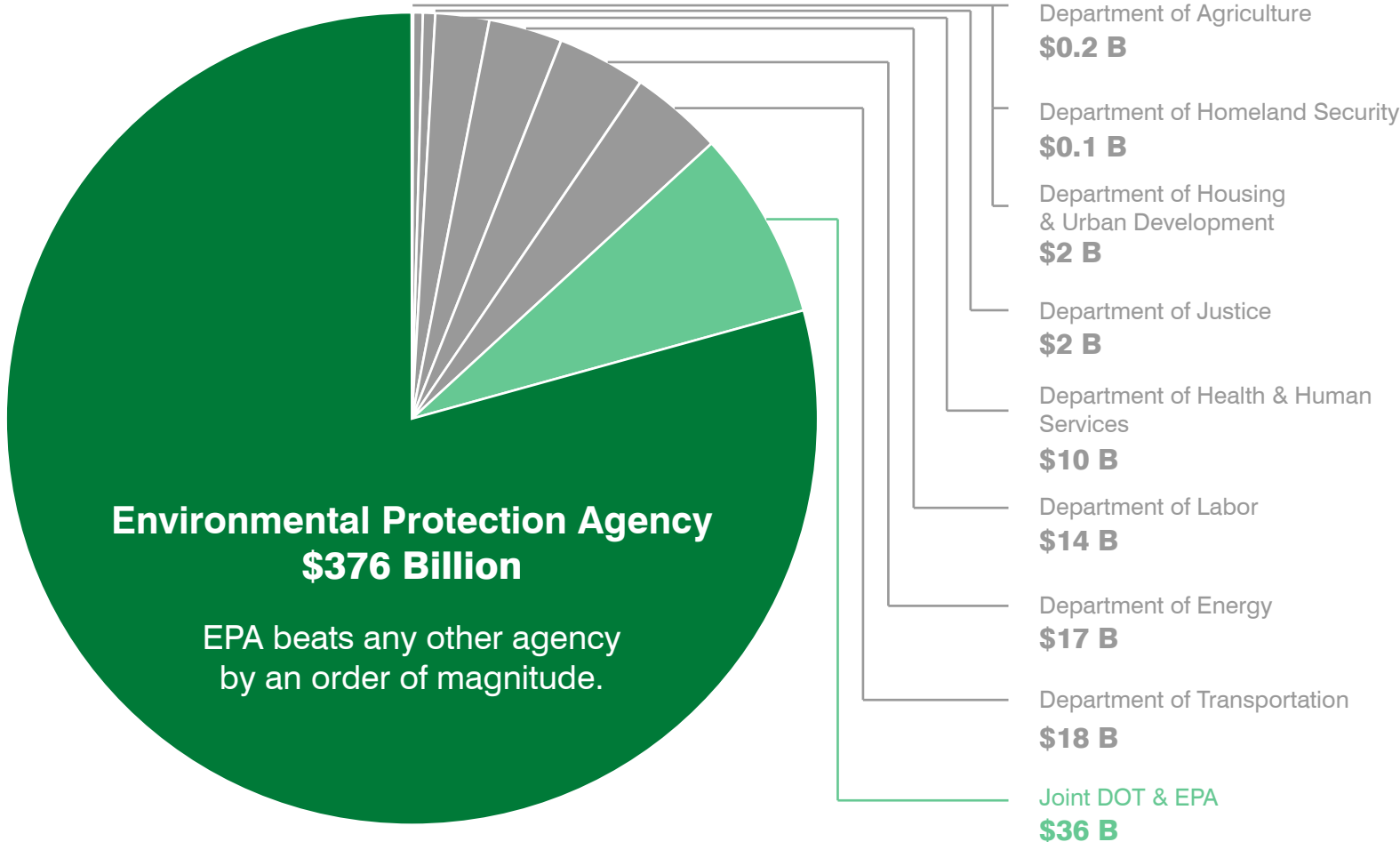
The number of dollars in social welfare created for each dollar society spends to comply with the regulation



EPA has \$9 in benefits for each \$1 spent.
 The closest second is the Department of Labor, with less than half the benefits: less than \$4 for every \$1 spent.

Total value of social benefits from each agency after subtracting costs

Net average benefits each agency is responsible for based on adding up costs & benefits of all major federal rules out of these agencies
