Dear Mr. Neltner:

This is in reference to your food additive petition, FAP No. 2B4831, which you submitted to the Food and Drug Administration (FDA or we) on January 31, 2022. Your petition requested that FDA “revoke uses of [bisphenol A (BPA)] for adhesives and coatings and strictly limit the migration of the substances into food from various plastic food contact articles.” On February 22, 2022, we responded to your submission, stating that we were not filing your petition due to incomplete information in accordance with 21 CFR 171.1(c)E. On April 6, 2022, you submitted a supplement to FAP 2B4831, which contained additional information for the petition.

The petition has been filed. The date of this letter is the filing date of your petition. If we are not able to complete the scientific review within 90 days of the date of this letter, we will inform you by letter and extend the review for an additional 90 days.
